TO ALL THE MEMBERS

Dear Comrade,

Ref: AIUCBOF Circular No. 5/2018-21 dated 30.0.2019

With grave concern we note the contents of the captioned Circular implicating the leaders of AOUCB-WB with hatching game plan to cause division in our beloved Association. The same set of leaders through their unstinted and committed contribution to Association/Federation was hailed for selfless service by the signatory of the said Circular. The sudden role reversal in thought process is extremely intriguing. **After failing to withstand the pressure of general members to allow representation to West Bengal in the Federation and demand for resumption of bilateralism with the Bank Management halted since 3 years**, AIUCBOF responded with knee jerk reaction to disaffiliate the largest Unit of the Federation in total disregard to the interests of the vast majority of the officers of West Bengal who have been paying Rs.1.67 Lac approx per month as affiliation fees to Federation since the conclusion of the 10th Triennial Conference in November 2018. In an utterly disgusting behavior, AIUCBOF through written communication demanded pro-rata affiliation fees for 13 days for the month of September 2019 having disaffiliated the State Unit on 14.09.2019. For the information of our members the money was paid forthwith even though AOUCB was not represented at the Federation. The crocodile tears being shed on disaffiliation of mighty Organisation AOUCB-WB are not only self implicating but explicitly expose the game plan of safeguarding the continuity of one retired individual at the helm of the affairs of trade union movement in UCO Bank without members' support and in gross violation to tenets of the Constitution of AIBOC which Constitutionally propagates for in-service leadership in Officers Organisation.

Confusing the membership with presence of retired leadership at AIBOA Confederation level to support presence of retired leadership at our Bank level Officers Federation level could only garner immediate support but shall backfire when the Comrades shall differentiate between bank specific Federation with whom the Management has denied negotiation and the constitutionality of retired leaders negotiating with IBA at National Level under the mandate of all the banks together. The Circular containing expression of bleeding hearts at disaffiliation of AOUCB-WB mocks of double standards and cunning mindset. This can be substantially proved by the fact that retired leaders of AIUCBOF started visiting branches/offices of the bank from 15.09.2019 seeking support of the same members whom they disowned to cause vertical divide in the Association for which their hearts bled profusely on the night of 14.09.2019 when they denied existence of the same members. Retired leaders including Mr. Subrata Sarkar, Office Bearer of Pensioner Federation who was expelled by the Chief Election Commissioner for campaigning on behalf of retired leader's panel can be found again shamelessly visiting branches in Howrah and imposing on young officers to resign from AOUCB-WB at the direction of his master. We are confident that new generation officers having logical and intelligent mindset would be able to draw requisite conclusion after differentiating the developments and make considered opinion in the best
